


2017 Neighborhood Drainage Phase II Project

Project Description: The 2017 Neighborhood Drainage Phase II Project consists of drainage improvements to seven sites throughout the City of Knoxville.

Work on the sites consist of:

- Middlebrook Pike at Unaka Street to alleviate roadway flooding;
- 810 Maryville Pike to alleviate roadway flooding;
- Wood-Smith at McKamey Road to alleviate roadway flooding;
- 3000 block of Lay Avenue to alleviate structure flooding;
- 2200 Martha Berry Drive to alleviate structure flooding;
- Keeble Avenue at Tomlinson Street to alleviate structure flooding;
- 6022 Ellesmere Drive to add capacity to alleviate system flooding.
