The Charge that has been Given to Our Office

- 1. Successfully house individuals who are homeless due to a disabling condition by coordinating the efforts of Knoxville's homeless service provider network.
- 2. Prevent homelessness for Knoxville's "at-risk" population by coordinating the efforts of Knoxville's homeless service provider network.

The Primary Cost Categories of our Efforts

- 1. Administrative City and County Funding in '09/'10
 - City: \$205m
 - County: \$50m
- 2. Affordable Housing Development Federal Pass-thru Dollars from the City and County Departments of Community Development
 - Minvilla: \$1.635M from the City (23% of project cost)

3. Supportive Services

- City: \$50m in '09/'10
- Philanthropic Community: \$350m in '09/'10
- HPRP Funds (HUD): \$300m for 2 Years
