Aluminum cans, steel cans, tin cans, & lids



Paper towels, napkins, or tissues








#1 and **#2** containers including cups, bottles, jugs, & secured caps



Cartons, cups, plates, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, books, shredded paper <u>secured in paper bags</u>, mixed paper, & envelopes





Plastic bags or flexible

plastic film of any thickness

Straws, stirrers, styrofoam, or plastic utensils












Food or dirty food wrappers Ink cartridges, batteries, light bulbs, or electronics











CARDBOARD

Shipping & toilet paper/paper towel tubes as well as flattened boxes including pizza, takeout, snack, & cereal boxes.

NOTE:

All recyclable containers must be rinsed out and free of any food.

GLASS

Glass can be recycled at designated drop-off centers only. Please do not put glass in the curbside carts. Visit our website for all drop-off locations.
