Stamp #1 is entirely new. It shall be placed on final plats when a Special Pollution Abatement Permit is involved. The permit must be approved and the number filled in. The Engineering Director or his representative will sign the stamp.

Stamp #2 is a revision of the current Engineering Department stamp. It shall be placed on all final plats. The Engineering Director or his representative will sign this stamp after all plat issues have been addressed and after all other stamps have been signed. This stamp must be signed before the Metropolitan Planning Commission will certify the plat for recording.

Although these new stamps may be used immediately, they will not be required until March 1. Plats submitted to the Metropolitan Planning Commission on or after March 1, 2003 must use these stamps.

We have rubber stamps and special mylar ink. If needed, we can hand stamp your plat here at the Engineering Department.
