



First Creek Greenway Project

Project Description: First Creek Greenway, Edgewood Park and Environs is a greenway project that connects Woodland Avenue to Edgewood Park. The greenway runs along First Creek along Fulton High School, crosses a new pedestrian bridge across First Creek to N Broadway and then continues down Edgewood Avenue to Edgewood Park, the North Knoxville Library, and the Larry Cox Senior Center. The City received concurrence from TDOT to award the contract to Wilson Construction Group LLC on Monday, September 19, 2016. This project is funded by a TDOT Enhancement Grant with 80% provided from the State of Tennessee and a 20% local match. Additional funds are provided from a TDOT Transportation Alternatives Program Grant with 80% provided by the State of Tennessee and a 20% local match. The City's match is budgeted under the Greenway Corridors line item in the Capital Improvements Budget.
