All other applicants should fill out the application that best fits their organization: Arts & Culture or Community & Social Services. If you are unsure, please ask.

Applicants should follow all instructions, provide attachments as instructed and make use of the check list. Please limit your responses to the space provided on the application form.

Priority will be given to proposals that contribute to the goals and mission of the City of Knoxville. Having received a Community Agency Grant in the past does not guarantee a grant this year. We strive to meet as many requests as possible within budget constraints.

The original signed applications must be received by Friday February 21, 2020, or hand delivered to the Mayor's Office by 4pm on the same date. Late applications will not be considered. If hand delivering, please allow time for parking and security.
