

Beaumont Elementary Sidewalk Improvements

Project Description: The City of Knoxville received a Safe Routes to School grant for pedestrian improvements at Beaumont Elementary School. The infrastructure improvements include new sidewalk and new traffic signs and markings to improve safety for pedestrians along Reed Street and W Scott Avenue. The non-infrastructure improvements include Education, Encouragement, Enforcement and Evaluation activities. All proposed activities are eligible for reimbursement by Tennessee Department of Transportation.
