

## City-Wide Guardrail Replacement Program

Project Description: This ongoing program allows the Department of Engineering to perform maintenance and installation of guardrails throughout the City. The program was initiated in 2017 and that contract expired in August 2020. During the previous three-year contract, approximately 1.9 miles of guardrail were replaced, including 79 crash-worthy end terminals, at a total cost to the City of approximately \$330,000.

This project consists of certain identified guardrail replacements as well as work that arises on an as-needed basis. The program was advertised using estimated quantities based on the average yearly installation over the previous three years. The contract will include two, one-year renewals under the same terms and conditions.
