



2022 Citywide Guardrail Replacement Program

Project Description: The guardrail replacement program allows Engineering to perform ongoing maintenance and installation of guardrails throughout the City. The program was initiated in 2017, and since then approximately 2.1 miles of guardrail have been replaced, including 113 crashworthy end terminals, at a total cost to the City of approximately \$390,000.



This project consists of certain identified replacements as well as work that arises on an as-needed basis. The program was advertised using estimated quantities based on the average yearly installation over the previous contracts.

The contract will include two optional one-year renewals under the same terms and conditions.
