

2022 Curb Cuts Project

Project Description: This project will install or improve approximately 67 curb cuts in existing sidewalks to make them fully accessible. It is generally the intent of this project to install curb cuts at locations that are planned to be resurfaced within the next few years. The July 12, 2022 change order approval will allow for nine additional curb cuts at Summit Hill Drive and Martin Luther King Jr Avenue and curb cut and sidewalk improvements at Summit Hill, Walnut Street and Wall Avenue to ensure ADA compliance. This change order will also add one bus shelter pad and a landing pad for KAT.
