

Project Description: The City of Knoxville has previously contracted with Quantum Environmental & Engineering Services, LLC to perform environmental testing and professional design services associated with the use or removal of twenty-three buildings on the campus of Lakeshore Park. The demolition of all the buildings has been completed. This contract will provide for the removal of three underground and one aboveground fuel storage tanks, the propane fuel system, all of the abandoned utility poles and associated lines, the removal of the kitchen and associated chillers at Central Services and a variety of other hardscapes throughout the campus. The City has entered into an agreement with Renascent, Inc. to perform this project.
