Engineering Department September 2022 Status: The construction contract was awarded at the December 15, 2020, City Council Meeting. A pre-construction meeting was held on March 23, 2021. Ball Camp Pike is reduced to one lane. The project is substantially complete and a final walkthrough was held on June 3, 2022. A ribbon-cutting was held on June 13, 2022. The project is complete.
