

Downtown Knoxville Wayfinding Project

Project **Description:** This project will alleviate visual clutter of signs in the Downtown area. While 247 new signs will be erected, roughly 400 existing signs will be removed. The new system will include gateway signs, a family of vehicular oriented signs, a family of parking signs and a family of pedestrian oriented signs to help residents visitors and to navigate downtown. The project area encompasses all of downtown including World's Fair Park. The general boundaries are the Norfolk Southern Tracks to the north, the Tennessee River to the south, Hall of Fame Drive on the east and 11th Street on the west.
