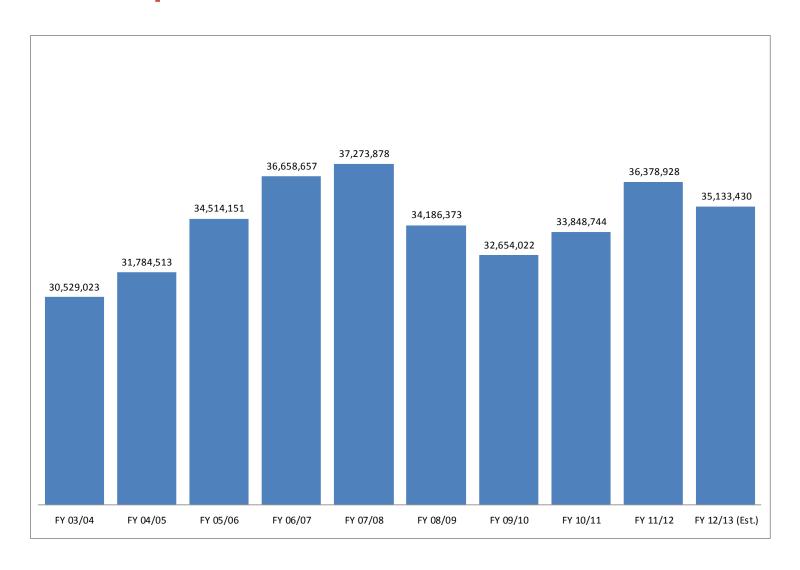

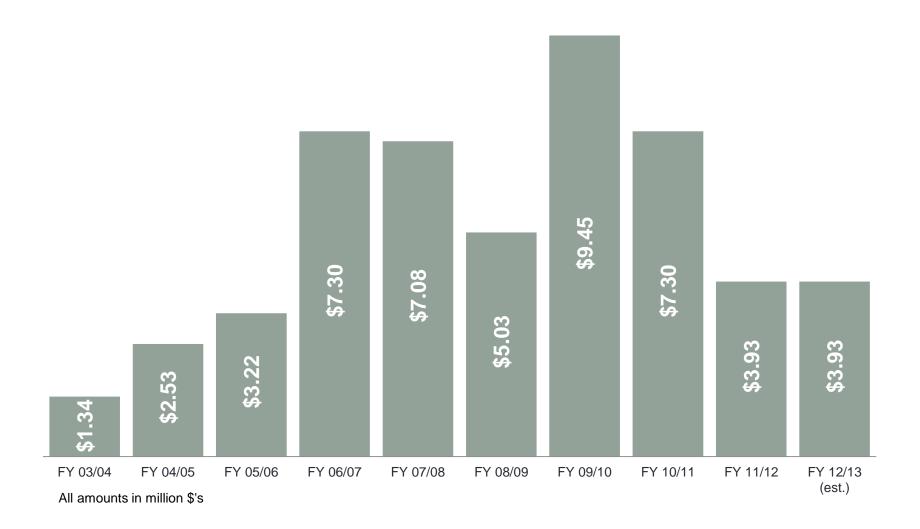
#### Mid-Year Forecast

# Local Option Sales Tax



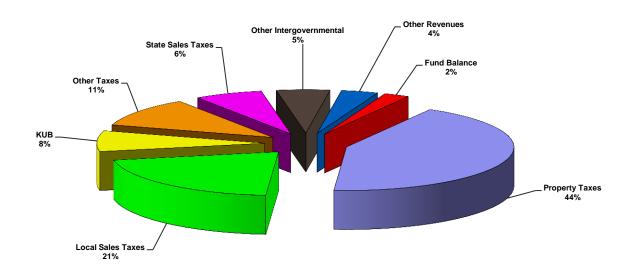
#### Hall Income Tax



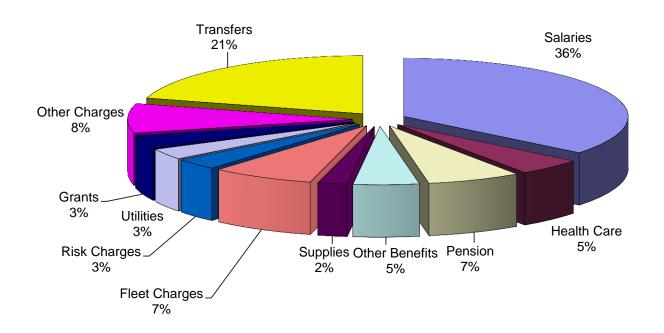
