HOW TO REGISTER

You can register for classes online at knoxvilletn.gov/kafcc, by phone at (865)523-1401, or in person. Payment is due at the time of registration and no later than **five working days** of the class start date. Please note that no student's space will be held without full payment. Cash, checks, and credit cards are accepted. We cannot prorate sessions. Online registration for all long classes (4, 5, 6, or 8-weeks) will open October 5th and will remain open for all long classes until 1 week prior to the class starting. Online registration for all 1, 2, and 3-Day workshops will open October 5th and will remain open until 3 business days prior to the start of class. After online registration is closed please call to check class availability. All registrations and payments made past the registration deadline will be subject to a late fee.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

All classes must meet the minimum enrollment requirement. Classes that do not meet the minimum enrollment at the registration deadline will be cancelled. Fees are 100% refundable if the class is canceled by Knoxville Arts and Fine Crafts Center. Students needing to cancel, should notify KAFCC as soon as possible. Refunds and credits are given at the discretion of the City of Knoxville.

Emily will be teaching pinching, coiling and slab-construction to create vessels such as mugs, bowls, and vases. Clay basics and glazing will also be covered. Initial clay, firings, glazes and Open Studio are all included in the cost of this class.

You will begin with simple still-life drawings and work up to creating a multi-hour sustained complex still-life drawing in charcoal. It is advised to take Learning to See: Line first, but not imperative.



We will provide you with plain 100% cotton fabric with matching thread and written instructions to refer to later. You will also need a sewing machine, fabric scissors, an iron, a ruler/tape measure, and straight pins. Some sewing experience recommended, but not essential.

The cost of this class includes enough material to make two pillow covers, (choice of color to be made at registration) and matching thread. Students will need to have the ability to pick materials up before the class and have access to a computer.

Have you ever wanted to turn your drawings into multiples? You can do just that with dry point etching. Start with a drawing and a piece of plexi-glass. Kelly will instruct you on how to etch your drawing into the plexi to get line and value. Take your time and get it just right and then schedule an in-person time to come and print your etching. The printing times will be scheduled individually. All participants will get an introduction demonstration on Chine-colle (printing collage) and an opportunity to try it when they come to print. All materials for printing, including paper will be provided for this class. Participants should be able to print an edition of 8-10 prints during their printing time. Students will need to be able to pick up materials and tools before class, return tools after and have access to a computer!
