

PLANS REVIEW – Fast Fact Sheet

The City of Knoxville's plan review process is now 100% digital.

No paper plans will be accepted, unless they are revisions that *originally* started as paper.

Process and Fees

- Applicants must submit a completed building permit application to
 <u>bldginspections@knoxvilletn.gov</u>. After the application is processed, the applicant will receive a
 welcome email from KnoxPlans with a link and instructions for uploading plans.
- Once plans are uploaded, the submission will be screened for formatting then the applicant will be sent an
 email to pay the plan review fee online. No plans will be reviewed until the review fee has been paid. After
 fees are paid, review cycles take approximately 10-14 business days.

Formatting Guidelines for Submission to KnoxPlans

- All files must be uploaded to the "Submit Drawings" folder.
- All drawings must be high resolution, single-page, PDFs. Multi-page drawings and other files types such as JPEG or PNG will not be accepted.
- Files must be in a **readable orientation** when opened (not sideways or upside down).
- Files must be **named simply**, ideally by the **page number** (e.g., "A-1", "A-2").
 - Do not include dates, long strings of numbers, or extra information in the file names (such as "Revision").
 - TIP: Think of your file name as a password for that drawing. Keep it simple.
 - In the event that your plans must be revised to address plan review comments, revised versions of files must have the **exact** same file name as the original drawing. This allows the file to overlap with the previously submitted version.
 - Files that have a naming scheme not matching the original submission will be rejected. For
 example, if a file was originally named "A-1" and the revised version is named "A-1 REV 1", it will
 not be able to overlap with the previous version and will be rejected.
- Supporting documents such as spec sheets, comment response letters, or calculations can be multi-page PDFs.

Completion of Review Cycle and Review Comments

- New drawings cannot be accepted during an open review cycle. The applicant will be sent an email notification when a review cycle is complete with instructions for the next steps.
- For projects requiring corrections, a conditions report detailing additional requirements will be located in the "Instructions and Conditions" folder along with contact information for the plans examiners.
- All revised drawings must be named exactly the same as the original versions.
- After the 3rd submission, each additional review cycle will be incur an additional review fee of \$100 minimum.
