Attend pre-bid meetings. It's the best opportunity for networking and to receive clarification on technical aspects of the solicitation.

- Prepare for the pre-bid meeting by carefully reading the solicitation documents, and formulating your questions in advance.
- Bring your business cards.
- Take notes. You may receive essential tips on how to write your bid proposal more effectively.
- Some pre-bid meetings are mandatory, so be sure to review the solicitation documents for the meeting schedule and requirements.
