- 1. All Participants must fill out and sign a participation waiver (see reverse side).
- 2. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian sign a waiver on their behalf.
- 3. No skating without a rink issued wristband.
- 4. Skates will be issued at the skate window. Double-blade skates are available for young children.
- 5. Skates are to be returned to the skate return window after use.
- 6. While wearing skates, please stay within the rubber floor area.
- 7. No one is permitted on the ice without ice skates.
- 8. No one is allowed on the ice while resurfacing is occurring.
- 9. Management reserves the right to interrupt or stop skating for ice resurfacing, special events, or for any other staff-related purpose.
- 10. No sitting or climbing on protective dasher boards.
- 11. No use of hockey sticks, pucks or balls.
- 12. No ice skating against the flow of traffic.
- 13. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 14. No carrying children on the ice.
- 15. No food, beverages or breakable objects are allowed on the ice.
- 16. No one is allowed to use the ice rink under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- 17. No profanity, obscene gestures or clothing allowed.
- 18. Participants are required to follow directions of the Ice Attendant and rink staff at all times.
